

# People

The WRU Hub Programme will provide the targeted training and tools to enable everyone involved in rugby to be the best they can be.

## Targets

100 new coach educators over the next (3 – 5 years)

100 hub officers given DIT course annually

Development and deployment of rugby leaders (1400), referees (500) and volunteers (New Target) throughout Wales annually

Specific support from Streetgames to support coaching children in areas of poverty





# Places

The WRU Hub Programme will identify those educational settings, WRU clubs and local communities where there is the most tangible benefit to be gained from the development of rugby

## Targets

Over 60% of clubs with M&J sections supported by Hub Programme

100% of female hubs supported by Hub Programme

600 CPDs delivered by Hub Officers to clubs and female hubs annually

Over 8000 attendees at these events

Targeted support of clubs/female hubs to recruit players at specific age groups.
